1. All entries to be entered on Monday, July 21, 2025, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.
2. All entries must be picked up on Monday, July 28, 2025, between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Premium money will be paid when exhibits are picked up. Premiums will be forfeited for entries not picked up by 9:00 a.m. July 28, 2025, unless other arrangements are made with the Fair Chairperson.
3. Any exhibits not picked up on Monday, July 28, will be taken to the McCracken County Extension Office and can be picked up after 12:00 p.m. on Monday, July 28.
4. Judging of exhibits will be Monday, July 21, 2025. Only workers and judges will be allowed in the Culinary, Crafts and Textiles section of Floral Hall during judging.
5. Exhibits are limited to McCracken County residents or members of a McCracken County organization, ages 18 and over.
6. Any exhibitor removing their exhibit before Sunday, July 27, 2025, will forfeit their prize money.
7. All articles in Crafts & Textiles must be handmade and completed within 3 years prior to this year's Fair to be eligible for entry in this department and must be the work of the exhibitor. **No store-bought items.**
8. All exhibits must be clean, or they will not be judged.
9. All professional or foreign work will be barred in this department. One who derives a major part of their income from the type of work being exhibited by them is considered a professional in this department.
10. Judges may, at their discretion, award a ribbon of such grade as the article deserves.
11. **EXHIBITORS** must determine the appropriate class for their entry at time of registration. Any article not up to standard in the class in which it is exhibited can be disqualified by the judge. Entries must remain in the category determined by the **EXHIBITOR.**
12. No exhibitor will be allowed to exhibit more than one article in any one class.
13. Family member(s) cannot enter "like" items.
14. An exhibitor winning a purple rosette in a class one year is barred from exhibiting the same article in that class the next year at the McCracken County Fair.
15. If there is more than one article in any exhibit (such as towels, table mats, etc.) they should be fastened together securely.¹

16. The management will not be responsible for any article exhibited but due care and diligence will be given in the handling of articles.
17. The Fair will not act as a selling agency. No articles can be shown in the department with a “For Sale” tag or contact information of the exhibitor attached.
Any sales must be between the owner and the prospective purchaser. The superintendent superintendent of the department will be glad to provide the name and address of the owner.
18. No pictures accepted unless framed and/or fixed for hanging.
19. The management will not be responsible for exhibits not picked up by 9:00 a.m. on July 28, 2025.
